Welland

- Recycle all plastic which packed all fabrics
- Recycle all paper pipe
- Recycle all thread spool.

Anjou

- By purchasing our own compactor we were able to reduce gas surcharges by 12%

MIP-e

As of February 2016 our entire electricity supply is "green". There is no energy sourced from coal-, oil- or nuclear power plants.

Instead, our energy is entirely sourced from ecological energy-sources.
