PRESSURE ULCERS: The Whole Story

What are they?

Pressure ulcers are injuries resulting from extended pressure interrupting blood flow to the skin, causing problems ranging from discoloration, loss of sensation and scarring to full-fledged skin loss and soft tissue damage.

How do they occur?

Pressure ulcers can result from pressure alone (when the skin is compressed between the bone and another surface, i.e.: mattress), or the combination of pressure and friction or shearing.

Who is at risk?

An estimated 7% of all hospital patients and residents are at risk of suffering from pressure ulcers over the course of their stay, the most vulnerable being:

- Older patients/residents
- Patients/residents who are bedridden for more than 2 days
- Patients/residents with impaired circulation
- Patients/residents who are not moved regularly
- Patients/residents whose heads are raised above a 30-degree angle (causes sliding and skin damage)

How can they be prevented?

Pressure ulcers are easier to prevent than to heal. Some useful ways may include:

- Using pressure redistribution devices to alleviate pressure from key points (heels, sacrum, trochanter, etc.)
- Checking skin daily for discoloration
- Unless contrary to the advice of a healthcare professional, ensuring the head of the bed is raised as little (no more than 30 degrees) and for as short a period as possible





Heel-Ease: Unique, Patented Support

- 1. Adjusts easily to patient or resident's leg length.
- Simply roll or fold to required position.

 2. Optimizes pressure management and blood flow.
 Position the upper part of the roll approximately 5 cm (2") above the ankles.
- **3. Secures support.**Close the zipper to maintain fold position and protect foam.

- Light slope at foot for better care of heels




